- COVID-Related Protocols:**
- It is recommended that players, coaches, and spectators check their temperatures at home prior to participating in or attending practices and games. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 or above should not participate in or attend practices or games. Be alert for symptoms. Watch for fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, chills, muscle or body aches, fatigue, new loss of taste or smell, etc.
  - Physical distancing and mask wearing by players and coaches is encouraged.
  - Pregame and postgame interactions between opposing coaches and players should adhere to physical distancing guidelines. Postgame handshake protocols are prohibited.
  - Spectators: Only immediate household members will be allowed to spectate. Physical distancing is required between households and all spectators are encouraged to wear a mask. Spectators must be 12' from the football field.
