STATE OF NEBRASKA SPORTS RE-OPENING PROTOCOL SPECTATOR GUIDELINES AT HACKBERRY PARK:

- Spectators must bring their own chairs or stand...bleacher use will not be allowed on Fields 2-5.
- No spectator seating or standing is allowed within 6' of the teams' dugouts/benches or within the area from behind home plate past the far end of each dugout. All spectator viewing should be done in the outfield area.
- Spectators should keep 6' of social distancing between different household units.
- Fans and players must leave the playing area and return to their cars immediately after the game.
- Spectators for upcoming games must remain in their cars during player warm ups. They should come to the field once the team they are there to watch enters the field.

Concussion Awareness Policy
