## 2021 LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION COURSE INFO

Upon successful completion of the Lifeguard Certification training course, participants will be certified in American Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid and CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer. All lifeguarding certifications are valid for 2 years with the exception that CPR/AED certifications must be updated every year per the State of Nebraska. **Step 1:** You need to register for and complete a <u>Pre-Course Skills Test:</u> Candidate must demonstrate: proficiency in both front crawl and breaststroke for 300 yards continuously; the ability to tread water without using their hands for 2 minutes; the ability to complete a timed element retrieving a 10lb brick from the 12-foot deep end. \*Pre-Course skills test typically will take less than 30 minutes.

**Step 2**: Upon successful completion of the pre-course skills test, you are eligible to register for a Lifeguarding Certification course.

<u>Lifequard RECERT students</u> can take one of the scheduled classes, but you will only be required to attend specific parts of the scheduled class for a certification renewal. If you were previously certified, but more than 30 days has passed, you will need to take the course in its entirety.
